2008 October Market Introductions

MANLIUS, NY, October, 17, 2008 — **OVER 450 YEARS OF FINE FURNITURE MAKING UNDER ONE ROOF NICHOLS & STONE DEBUTS AT STICKLEY SHOWROOM**

L. & J. G. Stickley, Inc. of Manlius, New York, continues to celebrate the 150th anniversary of Gustav Stickley's birth with several noteworthy additions to its historic Mission Collection. The company's modern side is also on display with a versatile 17 piece Greenwich Village Home Office system for its sleek Metropolitan Collection. In all, more than 35 casegood pieces, 30 upholstered frames, 75 new fabrics and leathers, and 17 new wood and painted finishes for upholstery will make their debut at Stickley's 225 North Elm Street showroom during the International Home Furnishings Market in High Point, North Carolina.

Nichols and Stone, established in 1857 in Gardner, Massachusetts, has recently joined the Stickley family of brands. It will retain the Nichols & Stone name and will be distributed independently of the Stickley brand. Nineteen **dining room groups**, made of solid birch and select hardwoods are available in a variety of styles and finishes. Nichols & Stone is proud to continue offering Williamsburg. Together these two great names put a fresh, new face on home décor by making furniture that blends the classic elegance of 18th Century design with today's relaxed comfort.

In the **Stickley Mission Collection** a versatile Display Buffet, available with two doors or three doors, is perfectly suited for storage or display. Its design is based on a rare early 20th century cabinet that Stickley reissued in 1994. A 32" high Open Night Stand with single drawer complements a number of Stickley Mission bedroom groups. As more and more people turn homeward for their entertainment pursuits, Stickley answers the growing demand with a **Motorized Theater Chair**, based on its popular Bow Arm Morris Chair. Available as a single, double or triple seat, the bustle-back chair features a motorized reclining mechanism. The chairs may be connected in several configurations using a Wedge Table that provides ample storage space.

The **Greenwich Village Home Office** gives business professionals another reason to telecommute and work from home. The 17 piece Greenwich Village Home Office is made of solid cherry with walnut accents and bases. It is centered around a choice of three work surfaces: a 62" Knee Hole Desk and 48" and 64 1/2" Table Desks with two or three drawers respectively. All desks have a fold-down keyboard drawer front and may be bunched in various configurations with a Corner Table Desk, two or three drawer File Drawer Units, a two door Cabinet, and square or rectangular End Tables. A 70" Credenza and a double wide File Cabinet with common base and top can both

accommodate a 70” Deck with ample shelf storage space. A 35” Deck is available to top off a wide two drawer File Unit. Three styles of ergonomic Swivel-Tilt Desk Chairs offer a leather-upholstered high or low back and an exposed wood slat back.

The Metropolitan Collection successfully merges tried and true Stickley craftsmanship with a contemporary attitude. In addition to the home office there are three new dining tables: a 46” diameter Dining Table with a fixed round top and a scalloped, round, fixed pedestal base; a 52” diameter Dining Table that extends to 82” with a scalloped, round, split pedestal base and two 15” aproned leaves; and a 48” diameter Dining Table with tapered legs that end in satin nickel sockets. The 48” table extends to 80” with two 16” aproned leaves. Two styles of Bow Front Night Stands are being introduced along with a new Tabouret Table and a splayed-leg 22” Bench with through-wedged leg tenons in the seat. All Metropolitan pieces are crafted from solid cherry with walnut accents.

Other introductions this market include a restyled Sleigh Bed and a restyled 84” Display Cabinet in the **Traditional Collection**. Sable marble tops will now be available as an option on two night stands and the single dresser in the **St. Croix Collection**.

Stickley Fine Upholstery and Craftsman Leather continue their steady growth with the introduction of 30 new frames, 17 new wood and painted finishes, nearly 60 new fabrics and 15 new leathers. Additions include the new Selectionals 200 Series in leather and a modular Angle Sofa, Chair and 1/2, and Twin Sleeper now included in the Selectionals Program. **Stickley Accents** debuts 17 new wood and painted finishes and 10 new exposed wood accent chairs. Stickley Comfort Zone Plus Recliners feature a fully adjustable, motorized option in several models. A series of seven Swivel Rockers is based on best-selling Stickley lounge chairs. Three new sofa and chair combinations are smaller-scaled for urban living, while two other sofa and chair pairings provide firmer support and more upright seating.
